Key Topics Covered

Good Judgment tailors private workshops to your organization's specific needs and forecasting questions, with half-day and full-day options that provide breakout sessions for applied forecasting practice in a small-group setting. We address key forecasting concepts, including:

- » What are key considerations and best practices when writing forecasting questions?
- » Which cognitive biases most strongly impact forecasting accuracy, and what are some strategies for minimizing them?
- » What weight should new evidence be given when updating forecasts?
- » Which strategies for aggregating individual forecasts yield the most accurate predictions?

Types of Workshops

Good Judgment offers three workshop formats:



Two-Hour Lectures:

two-hour lectures cover fundamental techniques for forecasting: debiasing individual forecasts and aggregating these into group forecasts.



Half-Day Workshops:

half-day workshops include an introductory lecture on fundamental techniques for forecasting, as well as a breakout session that provides concrete practice and rapid feedback on the skills taught in the lecture.



Full-Day Workshops:

full-day workshops incorporate significantly more material on teaming, with a second breakout session focused on the forecasting issues most relevant to workshop participants, as well as a session on translating problems into specific forecasting questions.

Workshop Components

Workshop structure and topics vary depending on the length of the workshop.

<p>Pre-Workshop Preparation</p> <p>On a kick-off conference call, the Good Judgment team learns about the particular threats and risks associated with your organization and how forecasting training may help. This information helps us tailor the workshop to your specific needs.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Forecasting Aptitude Test</p> <p>Each workshop attendee completes our Forecasting Aptitude Inventory, which measures various characteristics that Good Judgment Project research found to be correlated with accuracy in forecasting. Individual participants receive scores and feedback, and the anonymized results help us focus the training on specific areas of skill development that will be most useful for your team.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Calibration Test</p> <p>This test establishes whether participants are overconfident or underconfident in the predictions they make. Top forecasters “know what they know—and what they don’t know,” which pays major dividends in forecasting accuracy.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Debiasing Training</p> <p>This session exposes cognitive biases known to reduce forecasting accuracy and provides tools for combating their influence on your team’s predictions.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Breakout Practice Session</p> <p>We break the group into smaller teams, each led by a professional Superforecaster, to combine individual insights with group discussion—a process that enhances accuracy. The selected practice questions highlight how to apply different forecasting strategies (e.g., inside vs. outside views and Fermi estimates) and how to evaluate the diagnostic strength of new evidence.</p>		✓	✓
<p>Question Generation Training</p> <p>Good forecasting relies on translating problems into specific questions. This session covers key considerations when crafting questions, including objectivity, purpose alignment, and trade-offs.</p>			✓
<p>Second Breakout Practice Session Focused on Data Aggregation</p> <p>Teams forecast on the questions produced during Question Generation Training, then practice ways to combine individual forecasts into more accurate group forecasts without overfitting the data.</p>			✓
